



HMS Monmouth Limited Edition Signed Print "The Black Duke"



This wonderful Limited Edition Print of HMS Monmouth, with her bows majestically cutting through the waves as her Merlin Helicopter lands aboard, is both dramatic and superbly detailed. The original was presented to the Ship and still proudly hangs in the Captain's cabin aboard the "Black Duke" today.

HMS Monmouth is a Type23 "Duke" Class Frigate built by Yarrow on the Clyde. The ship owes her nickname to the infamous first Duke of Monmouth – executed for treason in the 17th Century when he unsuccessfully rose up against James II. The ship's links with the infamous duke extend to flying a plain black flag from her mainmast, making her instantly recognisable, and the name on her stern is painted black, not red – unlike any other ship in the Navy.

A limited edition of 235 prints, the ship's number (F235), has been produced so that others may share and enjoy this fine work. All the prints are numbered and signed by both the renowned artist Neil Foggo and Commander Tony Long RN, her Commanding Officer at the time of creation.

All profits are donated to deserving charities in the Ship's home region.
